## MUSTANG CRUISE—CARNIVAL CRUISE LINES

Cruise information and group rates:

This what I found out when I called Carnival.

A minimum of 8 cabins are needed to book at a group rate. I will have a meeting sometime in May with anyone that is interested. At the meeting we will look at different itineraries, dates and ships and perhaps decide on a cruise at that time. Once we have at least 8 cabins to book and a cruise picked out I will call Carnival and put a deposit on one cabin which will allow me to hold as many others as I need. I will then get a booking number.

You will then use that booking number to hold a "space". You will need to call Carnival directly to hold your space for a cabin, which will require a deposit. Or if you are ready you can go ahead and book at that time.

You **cannot** book online and then have it transferred to the group booking, it must be done by phone with the group number. You can use any online discount Carnival offers except the Casino offer. I was told the group rates are usually lower than what is seen online. I would suggest you research what cabin you would like and what the cost is before calling.

If you are not familiar with cruising costs I have come up with price ranges for you. Keep in mind the lower deck cabins are less expensive than the upper decks and balconies. The price for that time of year ranges from \$550 per person for a basic cabin to \$1200 per person for a balcony. That **includes** the taxes and port charges. That **does not include** airfare, pre-cruise hotel, shore excursions, gratuities, upgrades or incidentals. This is based on Carnival's website and as I said earlier it should be less expensive with the group rate but I have no idea how much that is until we start booking.

Steve and I prefer to go to the Southern Caribbean in the winter as you are not as likely to have cooler weather than as the Eastern Caribbean, but hey it is still warmer than **OHIO**. We also prefer to fly-in the day prior to allow for a winter weather airline disaster. But we will discuss all that at the meeting.

So far I have 5 other couples definitely interested. Which means so far I have 6 of the 8 necessary as long as no one changes their mind. If you want to go and are by yourself, perhaps we can buddy you up with another single who wants to go.

This cruise will go on even if we don't have 8 cabins, we will just book separately and not by group. I hope you decide to join in the fun! If you are not able to decide until it is closer to January then you can still book right up until sailing time as long as cabins are available. If you have any questions call or text me.
