direction.

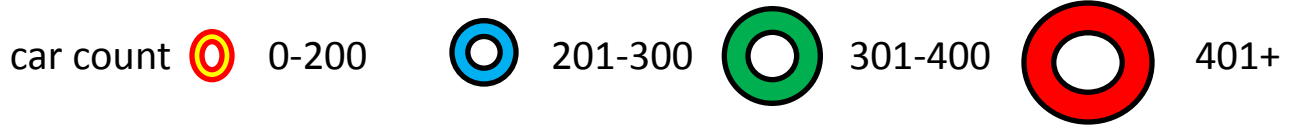
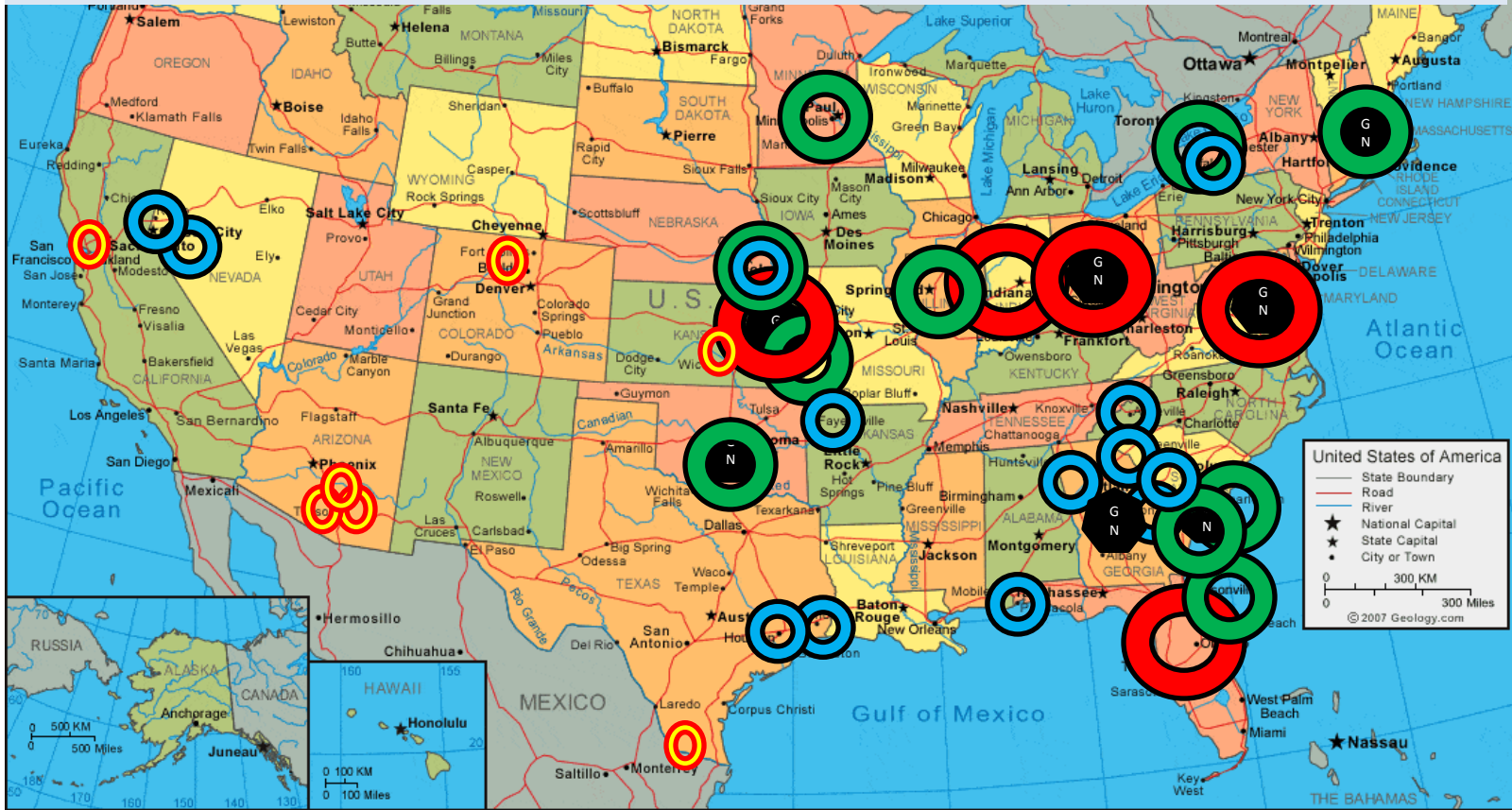
We also need to get our NEOM dues in
