General Meeting July 1, 2026

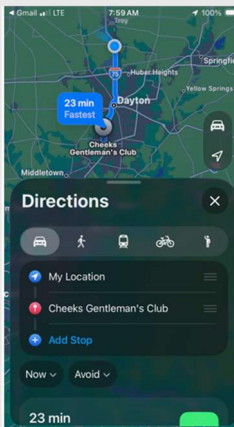

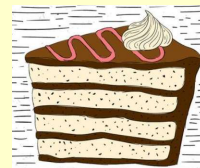

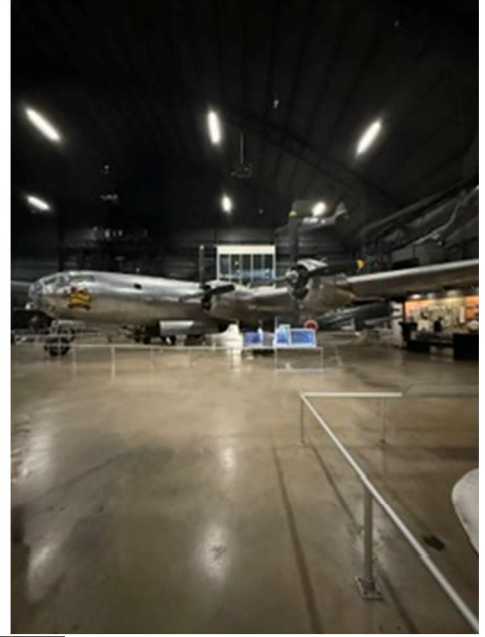
